Your Student's Classes at a Glance:

Reading/Language Arts: Spelling words for this week are: lie, pie, tie, night, light, right, been, found, cat's, and dog's. Students will be reviewing the long i with –igh and –ie. They will also be learning about singular possessives. We will continue writing about winter and students will be creating a Winter Book this week. Students will also be writing about different sounds to go along with what we have been studying in science class.

Math: Students will spend this week reviewing the values of the penny, nickel, dime, and quarter. They will be counting money and “buying” objects as well.
