## *Your Student's Classes at a Glance:*

**Reading/Language Arts:** This week we will be reading a nonfiction selection about Egypt and a nonfiction story about mummies. We will be working on an art project on Tuesday. There will be no spelling test this week.

**Math:** Students will take an end of the year assessment. We will use the rest of the time to review concepts that have been a struggle to master.

**Science:** This Thursday, May 20<sup>th</sup> is our last test in Science for the year. Students will take the chapter 4 test over Astronomy. Some of the main ideas to review are Earth's movements, the moon's movements, the eight planets in our solar system, distant planets, and other objects in our solar system. The key vocabulary words to know are: axis, rotation, orbit, revolution, satellite, solar system, ellipse, asteroid, meteor, meteorite, comet, and constellation.
